KGC Examination in Engineering – Revision (03) – April 2022

1. The Kerala Government Certificate Examination in Engineering (Rev – 03) for the branches of Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Automobile Engineering, Refrigeration & Air Conditioning, Electronics & Communication Engineering, Radio & Television Engineering and Operation & Maintenance of Agricultural Machineries programmes will be conducted during the month of October 2022 by the Controller of Technical Examinations, Thiruvananthapuram.
2. Centers for Theory and Practical Examination will be announced later and no request for change of examination centres allotted shall be entertained.

Minimum qualification and rules for appearing the Examination

3. The minimum qualification for admission to the Examination is S.S.L.C (Passed) or equivalent and candidate must have completed the prescribed course of study in the concerned branches for two years in Engineering Institution duly recognized by the Government securing not less than 80% attendance. Candidates should have obtained Permanent Register Number (PRN) from Controller of Technical Examinations (CTE).
4. The failed candidates need to appear only for failed subjects on the subsequent sitting.
5. Candidates will not be allowed to register for the Examination in piecemeal. They shall register all the subjects in which they have to pass.
6. A candidate will be allowed to appear for the Examination only for four chances within the validity of registration time. They will have to pass the whole Examination within four consecutive chances offered by the CTE. Candidates of 2017 and later admissions only are eligible to apply as per this notification.
7. Application for Registration need be made online in the portal www.sbte.kerala.gov.in. Candidates can register for the examination through their login.
8. Regular candidates who have updated their profile in the portal can make the examination registration through their login.
9. Supplementary candidates (who have not updated the profile yet) need to update their profile and then do the examination registration.
10. All entries in the registration window need be carefully filled in and the registration process completed with the online submission of the form and the payment of fee required (As applicable).
11. Candidates are required to keep the reference id of the registration. There is no need to submit the printout of the application to the institution or to the Office of the Controller of Technical Examination.

12. Fees for the Examination is as follows

- i) For Regular Examination: - **Rs.660/-**
- ii) Supplementary Examination (Theory/Practical): - **Rs.170/- per paper**
- iii) In addition to examination fee as above, for Practical Examinations: - **Rs.170/- per paper** is to be paid to the chief superintendent of examination centre before appearing for the practical examination.

13. The fee for the examination shall be remitted through online mode along with the registration. Payment through other modes will not be accepted.

14. Remittance of fee will not be a claim for writing the examination. Only candidates meeting the conditions of eligibility shall be treated as bonafide candidates.

15. Amount of examination fees once remitted will not be refunded or adjusted towards fees for subsequent examination on any account.

16. The fee concession status of candidates eligible for Fee concession (SC / ST / OEC candidates, for whom fee concession is approved by the development department) shall be updated by the Principals of the institutions. It shall be the responsibility of the institutions concerned to remit the fee to the Controller of Technical Examinations.

17. Extra time up to 10 minutes per hour for the scheduled duration of each theory paper for all papers of the examination is sanctioned to Physically handicapped candidates with 40% or above disability as per GO(MS) No. 09/92/HEdn dt. 06.01.1992. Such candidates should obtain permission from the Director of Technical Education in this regard.

18. Malpractice:- Malpractice in any form during the examination is not permitted. Candidates indulging in malpractices are liable to undergo punishment as contained in GO(Rt) No. 1077/2020/HEdn dt. Thiruvananthapuram, 24.08.2020.

19. Candidates should be use only blue or black ink for written examinations.

20. Time Table for the examination will be published in the portal www.sbte.kerala.gov.in

21. Publication of Results:

The results of the examination will be published in www.sbte.kerala.gov.in

22. Finalisation of Results:

The results of the examination shall be finalized on the day of completion of 4 months from the publication of results. No change in the examination results shall be permitted after the finalization of results / printing of original certificate or Mark list of the candidate whichever is earlier.

The claims for Grace marks are expected to be submitted well in advance to the publication of results and in any case not later than 3 months from the date of publication of results.

23. Issue of Mark list / Certificate:

- a. The issue of Mark lists / Certificates shall be as per GO(Rt) No. 1077/2020/Hedn dt. Thiruvananthapuram, 24.08.2020.
- b. Successful candidates shall be issued Mark list / Certificates by the Controller of Technical Examinations.
- c. Original Certificates / Mark lists shall be issued on the Online request of the candidate and the same shall be sent to the address of the candidate in India in Speed post. Required fee need be remitted Online for the same. Results shall be finalized on the issue of the Original certificate / Mark list and no change shall be entertained later.
